

## NOTES:

- 1. DASHED LINE INDICATES MANUAL SET CONNECTIONS.
- FOR EXCLUSION ON LINE I, CONNECT (Y)[R-Y] AND (BK)[G-Y] EXCLUSION KEY LEAD TO TERMINALS I AND 2 RESPECTIVELY; FOR EXCLUSION ON LINE 2, CONNECT (Y) R-Y AND (BK)[G-Y] EXCLUSION KEY LEADS TO TERMINALS 3 AND 4 RESPECTIVELY.
- SET WIRED FOR RINGING ON LINE 1. FOR RINGING ON LINE 2 CONNECT (R) AND (BK) RINGER LEADS TO TERMINALS 3 AND 4 RESPECTIVELY.
- 4. A 7-TYPE BUZZER ON A 448 BRACKET MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR THE RINGER AS A COMMON OR PRIVATE LINE AUDIBLE SIGNAL.
- 5. TO SILENCE RINGER PERMANENTLY, CONNECT (BK) RINGER LEAD TO TERMINAL K ON NETWORK.
- ON LATER MODEL SETS, CONNECTIONS TO TERMINALS 5 AND 6 HAVE BEEN TRANSPOSED.
